

RECOGNITION OF CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY ISSUED BY FOREIGN MARITIME ADMINISTRATIONS (NMA_C53.2025.Rev.0)

DEFINITION:

The following abbreviations stand for:

- "STCW" International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended
- "STCW-F" International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Fishing Vessel Personnel, 1995, as amended
- "COC" Certificate of Competency
- "COE" Certificate of Endorsement

The term "Administration" refers to the Nauru Maritime Administration.
