

# IMPLEMENTATION OF INVENTORY OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (IHM) (NMA\_C54.2025. Rev.0)

# (a) **DEFINITIONS**:

The following abbreviations stand for:

- 1. EU European Union
- 2. EMSA European Maritime Safety Agency
- 3. HKC The Hong Kong International Convention for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships, 2009
- 4. IHM Inventory of Hazardous Materials
- 5. ITC 69 International Convention on the Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969
- 6. PSC Port State Control
- 7. RfRC Ready for Recycling Certificate
- 8. RO Recognized Organization as defined by IMO Resolution A.789(19)
- 9. SoC-IHM Statement of Compliance on Inventory of Hazardous Materials
- 10. SRR Ship Recycling Regulation

The term "Administration" refers to the Nauru Maritime Administration.

### (b) PURPOSE:

This circular provides information relating to the implementation of the **HKC**, to ships calling at a port or anchorage of any country of the **EU** and providing instructions on issuance of **SoC-IHM** and Part I of the **IHM**.

#### (c) REFERENCE:

#### (d) APPLICATION:

This circular applies to Nauru-flagged vessels of 500 GT and above including:

- 1. New ships (built on or after 26 June 2025).
- 2. Existing ships preparing for recycling after 26 June 2025 must carry a valid RfRC.
- 3. Ships calling a State party to the HKC.
- 4. By **25 June 2030**, all existing Nauru-flagged ships must:
  - Have an approved IHM Part I, II & III,
    - Hold a valid SoC-IHM, and
    - Be ready for recycling compliance if applicable.

## (e) CERTIFICATION:

- 1. All applicable ships must carry a valid **SoC-IHM** issued by RO.
- 2. Ships calling EU ports must comply with both HKC and EU SRR (EU SRR No. 1257/2013).

3. Separate SoCs should be issued for HKC and EU SRR where applicable.

### (f) ACTION REQUIRED:

- 1. Shipowners, managers, and ROs are to ensure IHM certification and maintenance is done per **MEPC.269(68)**.
- 2. RO may issue SoC-IHM upon request after completion of required surveys
- 3. **IHM** must be updated and maintained during the ship's life.
